Pauline Stucky, 76, died suddenly at her home southwest of Lennox on Friday morning, February 25, 2011, the result of heart failure. Pauline Lois Peachey was born October 12, 1934 in Allensville, Pennsylvania, the daughter of Raymond and Eldora (Hertzler) Peachey.
