



Pearl Wildeboer

May 14, 1924 - August 9, 2024

Pearl Wildeboer, age 100, passed away, August 9, 2024, under hospice care at the Inn at Westport, Sioux Falls, SD. Pearl Ruth Twedt was born on May 14, 1924, at Worthing, SD, the daughter of Engvald and Martha (Bultena) Twedt. She grew up attending rural school near Worthing and then completed two years of high school. On April 5, 1941 she was united in marriage to Raymond Hardy at Rock Rapids, IA. The couple farmed in the Worthing and Lennox area for 21 years, before moving to Sioux Falls in 1963. Raymond died on May 4, 1989. On September 11, 1993 she married Harm Wildeboer in Sioux Falls. This couple made their home on a farm near Chancellor. Harm died on December 19, 2015. Pearl moved to the Inn at Westport in 2016. Pearl worked in creating, selling and teaching ceramics for over 49 years. She was a member of Grace Community Church, Sioux Falls and enjoyed gardening, canning, cooking and puzzles. Besides her parents and two husbands, Pearl was preceded in death by two brothers, Verlyn Twedt in 1945 and Arlin in 2024. Grateful for having shared her life are several nephews, nieces, step-relatives, other relatives and friends

Services will begin at 10:00 a.m. Saturday, August 17 at the Dindot-Klusmann Funeral Home, Lennox, SD, with burial to follow in the Worthing Cemetery, with visitation beginning one hour prior to the service.
