Robert Nesseim, age 94, passed away, February 22, 2025, at the Good Samaritan Luther Manor, Sioux Falls, SD. Robert Lee Nesseim was born on December 16, 1930, at Lake Preston, SD, the son of Jack and Hazel (Anderson) Nesseim. He attended school here and graduated from Lake Preston High School in 1949. Robert served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War, from 1952, until his honorable discharge in 1956. On May 19, 1951, Robert was united in marriage to Juanita Hilbrands, at Luverne, MN. The couple lived in California until Robert's Naval service ended, and then moved to Sioux Falls in 1957. They moved to Tea in 1959 and their acreage near Tea in 1966. Robert worked as a welder/bridge builder. He was employed by Hassenstein Steel and then Egger Steel, completing projects in several states, for 43 years. He was proud to have worked on the bleachers for the Cheyenne Frontier Days rodeo arena and also operated his own welding shop in Tea. Wife, Juanita passed away on April 21, 2014. Robert was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church, Tea, the Tea American Legion Post #266, the VFW Post #628, Sioux Falls and the Boilermakers Local #647 union. He enjoyed wood and steel working, but his passion was horses and restoring antique horse drawn buggies and wagons. Most of all Robert was a devoted husband, father and grandfather, who deeply loved his family. Besides his parents and wife, Robert was preceded in death by two brothers, John "Wes" Nesseim and Bill Nesseim. Naatjes, Lennox; five grandchildren, ten great-grandchildren and his great-great-grandchildren, as well as other relatives and friends.
