Roger Dale Almond, 62, of Lennox, SD, died Sunday, July 5, 2015 due to injuries from a motor vehicle accident which occurred north of Lennox. Roger Dale Almond was born in Sioux Falls, SD, on November 2, 1952, the son of Robert and Audrae (Stoddard) Almond.
