Roger Rehder, 73, passed away, Sunday, September 25, 2022, at his rural Beresford, SD, home, under hospice care.

Roger John Rehder was born on September 27, 1948, at Sioux Falls, SD, the son of John and Dorothy (Groen) Rehder. He attended Burney country school and then Lennox High School, graduating in 1966. Roger went on to serve in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War from 1969 until his honorable discharge in 1970.

On May 24, 1969 he was united in marriage to Vikki Holm at the Emanuel Lutheran Church, Beresford. The couple made their home near Beresford. Roger was a farmer and an over the road truck driver who hauled the U.S. Mail.
