



## Rosella Oltmanns

August 29, 1939 - January 7, 2017

Rosella Oltmanns, 77, of Lennox, SD, died Saturday, January 7, 2017, at the Bethany Lutheran Nursing Home, Sioux Falls, SD. Rosella Lier was born on August 25, 1939 in South Dakota, the daughter of Alvin and Alice (Schoffelman) Lier. She attended Crowley rural school and graduated from Lennox High School in 1957. On October 17, 1957 she married Elroy Oltmanns at the Presbyterian Parsonage in Lennox. The couple farmed southwest of Lennox and then northeast of Lennox, moving into Lennox in 1999. Rosey worked several clerical jobs in Sioux Falls. In 1984 she began work at Dakota Heritage State Bank in Chancellor, retiring after 20 years. Elroy died October 30, 2010. Rosella had been a member of LaValley Presbyterian Church, transferring to Faith Presbyterian Church in 1984. She and Elroy enjoyed yearly trips to Duluth, MN and to Canada and eastern Iowa to visit friends and relatives. She will be remembered for sense of humor.
