Steven Javers, 69, Lennox, SD, died Thursday, November 28, 2019 at Ava's House Hospice, Sioux Falls, SD, following complications of a brain aneurysm in 2000 and a recent stroke.

Steven Ray Javers was born at Sioux Valley Hospital in Sioux Falls, SD, on May 8, 1950, the son of Raymond and Katie (Nordmann) Javers. He lived in the Worthing, Chancellor, Tea and Lennox areas. He attended Hills rural school near Worthing and Dirksen District 4 rural school near Chancellor before graduating from Chancellor High School in 1968. Steven worked on the family farm and also assisted other area farmers. He had worked at a grain elevator, the Lennox Lanes Bowling Alley and as a bartender at the Lennox Legion.
