Funeral Mass for Tanner Joseph Bainbridge, 15, of Lennox, South Dakota will be held Wednesday, November 3, 2010 at 1:30 P.M. at the Lennox High School Gymnasium with Fr. Joe Vogel celebrant. Interment will be in the Lennox Cemetery, rural Lennox. Visitation will be held Tuesday, November 2nd from 4:00 P.M. until 7:00 P.M. at the St. Magdeline's Catholic Church. Tanner was born November 11, 1994 in Aberdeen, South Dakota. He was baptized at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Mobridge, South Dakota. He attended school at St. Michael's Catholic School in Sioux Falls before moving to Lennox in 2004. Tanner was active in athletics; playing football, basketball and baseball and was active with FFA. He enjoyed boating, skiing and wake boarding. Tanner was also an honor student. Tanner will be best remembered his great sense of humor, his fun loving attitude and his ability to always put a smile on your face. Tanner passed away on October 29, 2010 from injuries received in a motor vehicle accident.
