Terry Scott, 66, of Worthing, SD, died Saturday, August 7, 2021, at Sanford USD Medical Center, Sioux Falls, SD.

Terry Dene Scott was born on December 16, 1954, at Sioux Valley Hospital in Sioux Falls, SD, the son of Stanley and Edna (Swanson) Scott. He grew up in Sioux Falls, attending school and graduated from Washington High School in 1973. He went on to earn an Associates Degree in Criminal Justice from Ashworth College, Norcross, Georgia. Terry was also an ordained minister, certified chaplain and had been an Emergency Medical Technician. He worked for 32 years at Lewis Eastgate in Sioux Falls and as a Certified Nursing Assistant at the Lennox Good Samaritan Center for 20 years and at Bethesda Assisted Living, Beresford for 6 years.

On March 5, 1977 he was united in marriage to Lynette Meyers. The couple made their home in Worthing. His death ended a marriage union of over 44 years.

Terry was a member of the West Prairie Lutheran Church, Lennox and the E1 Raid Shrine in Sioux Falls. He had belonged to the Worthing Fire Department for several years and had served as Assistant Chief. He had also been a member of the Lennox Area Ambulance. Terry loved to ride and work on motorcycles, ride bicycles, construct model trains and go antiquing on the weekends. He enjoyed cars and car shows and had restored and showed a 1979 Pontiac Firebird. Most of all, Terry loved his family.

Besides his parents, Terry was also preceded in death by a sister Kathy Scott

and a step-mother, Karen Scott.
