Tressa Burfeindt, 89, died on June 9, 2011 at her home in Pembroke Pines, Florida, while under hospice care. Tressa Clarine DeNeui was born on a farm near Chancellor, South Dakota on June 7, 1922, the daughter of Peter and Gertrude (Iben) DeNeui. She attended Chancellor Public School and graduated from Chancellor High School in 1940. On June 22, 1941 she was united in marriage to Raymond Burfeindt at Hartington, Nebraska. They lived in Chancellor their entire married life. They owned and operated Burfeindt Trucking Service for 30 years until her husband's health problems caused them to sell their business. Her husband died on September 21, 1995. She moved to Florida in 2000 to be near her son, Douglas, and his family. Tressa was a faithful member of First Baptist Church where she served as church custodian for a number of years. Besides her parents and husband she was preceded in death by her infant daughter, Ardes June in 1945; her son, Dennis James, on March 14, 1989; two brothers: Arthur DeNeui and Raymond DeNeui.
