Vera Steever, 95, of Tea, SD, died Thursday, April 25, 2019 at the Lennox Assisted Living Center.

Vera Rianna Schoffelman was born on December 6, 1923, on a farm near Tea, SD, the daughter of John and Hattie (Straatmeyer) Schoffelman. She attended school in Tea and graduated from rural school District 4. In early life she worked for different families.

On December 15, 1943 she was united in marriage to Eldon Steever at her parental home. The couple farmed in the Lennox-Tea areas their entire lives. Eldon died on December 16, 1994. Eldon's death ended a marriage union of 51 years. Vera continued to live on the family farm until March 6 of this year, when she moved to the Lennox Assisted Living Center.

Vera had attended the Salem Presbyterian Church and was a life long member of Lennox Ebenezer Presbyterian Church. She enjoyed gardening, baking, crocheting, and cards with her grandkids. Most of all, Vera loved her family.

In addition to her husband, Vera was preceded in death by her parents. She was the last surviving family member of her generation.
