Verda Jean Goeman, 90, died Tuesday evening, July 5, 2011 at Riverview Manor in Flandreau, SD. Verda Jean Reiners was born at Lennox, South Dakota on May 31, 1921, the daughter of Joe and Matie (Dede) Reiners. She grew up near Lennox and attended LaValley rural school. On April 28, 1941 she was united in marriage to Ernest Goeman at First English Lutheran in Lennox.
