Verna Stubsten, 91, of Sioux Falls, SD, died Sunday, August 11, 2019 at the Good Samaritan Village, Sioux Falls.

Verna Faye Fixmer was born at Ellsworth, MN, on December 2, 1927, the daughter of August and Myrtle (Essman) Fixmer. She grew up attending Ellsworth Public Schools and graduated from Ellsworth High School.

On January 23, 1949 she was united in marriage to Dean Stubsten in Ellsworth, MN. The couple lived in Sioux Falls and then moved to Lennox in the early 1950's. Dean and Verna owned and operated Stubsten's Flower House in Lennox for 16 years, having sold the business in 1980. They moved back to Sioux Falls in June of 1985. Husband, Dean died on March 22, 1993. Verna was a member of the First English Lutheran Church in Lennox where she had taught Sunday school. She was also an RSVP volunteer. Verna was a very artistic and creative person, who in addition to her flower arranging talents, also enjoyed painting, ceramics and other crafts. She was a devoted wife and mother.

Besides her parents and husband, Verna was preceded in death by one son, Lee Stubsten in 2009 and all of her siblings: Darlene Peters, Corrine Stark, Shirley Fixmer, Marilyn Ratner, Lloyd Fixmer and Dave Fixmer.
